

## **New Covenant Terms of Service:**

By being on the New Covenant United Methodist Church's website, you agree to the **Terms of Service**;

Anything on the website is owned by New Covenant; you agree they can do with it what they like, and you'll respect their copyrights. Also, they can remove any parts of their website without notice and you agree that that's fine.

Leave the New Covenant files alone. Also, you can only create other stuff based on New Covenant stuff if you get permission from the Webmaster or Communications Officer.

Saying that you are any member of the New Covenant staff when you're not may get you into trouble.

Be mindful of the laws in your country/state/city.

Any opinions on the website are the opinions of individual writers. New Covenant doesn't necessarily agree or disagree with an opinion and you understand that one person doesn't represent New Covenant's views.

Illegal activities using the New Covenant website may get you into trouble.

If you exploit a bug or error, or tell anyone about one (real or fake), you may get into trouble. Also, if you come across a bug that people can exploit, you should tell the New Covenant Webmaster.

Hacking the servers or decrypting information transferred between servers may get you into trouble.

Anything owned by someone else that you use without permission may get you into trouble.

If you're under 13, New Covenant thinks you should get your parents to explain the Terms of Service to you.

New Covenant will keep your details private; this includes any information you submit to them at any time. However they reserve the right to use your ideas that you submit to them.

There are times when you just won't be able to access the New Covenant website. You accept that.

New Covenant owns everything on its website. You agree only to use things from the website within New Covenant and must get permission to use content from the website from the Webmaster.

New Covenant doesn't have to remove anything, but it will do so when it wants to.

There is no warranty with anything New Covenant produces for your use; if there are errors, then there are errors.

New Covenant isn't responsible for any links posted to sites not owned by New Covenant.

If you break the Terms of Service or the law while using the New Covenant website, you agree that you're the one responsible for what happens, not New Covenant.

New Covenant isn't responsible for your inability to use the website, or any damages or losses you suffer from things like your internet connection going down or your computer hard drive frying, etc. If your internet connection is slow or your computer can't handle the website, don't blame New Covenant for that.

New Covenant will make sure any changes made to the Terms of Service are available to you.

New Covenant has other rights under law that aren't listed here; you should be mindful of the law.

New Covenant owns the New Covenant website. By being on it, you also agree that you have the right to agree to these Terms of Service under law.

Your use of any/all of the New Covenant website is subject to these Terms of Service.

New Covenant recommends that you check up on the Terms of Service regularly to see if there are updates, because it has no obligation to alert you when there are changes. If you disagree with any of the Terms of Service you should stop using the website.
